

HSSA RANGE SAFETY RULES

(Masks are required)

- 1. Masks are required only when you are within 6 feet in a group of 2 or more (This rule is Subject to change based on data).
- 2. Always- keep firearms pointed in a safe direction.
- Always- keep your gun unloaded until you are at the firing line and ready to shoot. Guns should be cleared of any ammunition before entering or leaving the firing line with Chamber Flag Showing.
- 4. Always- keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- 5. Always- maintain social distancing of 6 feet and wear your mask.
- 6. **ComenceFiring-** Only when instructed to do so by a RSO.
- 7. Cease Firing- When anyone calls a cease fire immediately stop shooting.
- 8. **Never-** Handle your gun at the firing line when anyone is down range.
- At any Time- You experience a stoppage or you are unsure of the operation of your firearm, with your finger off the trigger point your firearm in a safe direction (Down Range) and consult with one of the designated Range Safety Officers.
